Oxford Township Trustees Minutes October 12, 2010

124-10 Call to Order

At 7:00 p.m. Mr. Salmon called the meeting to order at the Oxford Township Building

125-10 Approval of the Agenda

Mr. Frimerman moved, Mr. McDonough seconded the motion to approve the agenda as presented.

126-10 Recognition of Guests

Jim Wachenheim and Steve Mays who reside on Ringwood Road requested an update on the railroad crossing on Ringwood Road, thanked the road department for the chevron signs installed on the road, and appreciate the paving done on Taylor Road. Mr. Salmon's update on the crossing is that the underground stands for the lights and gates have been installed and the Township is waiting, just as they are for the completion of the job. The CSX Railway is in the process of replacing ties and repairing crossing from Hamilton, Ohio to Cottage Grove Indiana and this might slow down the installation of the gates and lights. The PUCO has given them a year to do the project which will be sometime in the spring of 2011.

Todd Dockum director of the Miami Heritage Technology Park located at 4450 Trenton Oxford Road gave the Trustees an update of his quest to develop the Park. He sent a letter to the City Manager of Oxford requesting water and sewer services from the city and wishes the city to consider a JEDD with Oxford Township. He shared the response letter that he had received from Oxford City Manager, Douglas Elliott Jr. with the Trustees. The letter states that the City of Oxford will provide sewer and water to the Park with the condition that the property will be annexed into the City of Oxford. Mr. Dockum expressed the need for the City, Miami University, and Oxford Township to jointly support the Technology Park in order to attract potential business to the site. The Trustees and Mr. Dockum discussed several items concerning the development site that need to be resolved among all the parties involved. Mr. Salmon is to contact the Mayor of Oxford,

Richard Keebler and schedule a work session with City Council or a sub committee of council.

Cemetery Report

Mr. Hoelle reported that a headstone is broken at the cemetery and he has removed the broken part and placed in the Township Building until repairing arrangements have been made.

Road Report

Mr. Hoelle reported that the road department has finished mowing the roadways probably for the last time this year. They are awaiting the crack sealing equipment to begin sealing cracks on some of the Township roads. This will be the first time that they have done this and are going to do a few roads to see if this is a good thing to do. He has contacted Terry Material to get other resurfacing options other than paving of roads. They have provided him with other options and cost estimates which he presents to the Trustees. He requested that the Trustees pass another resolution for the design and replacement of more culverts on Bonham Road. The Engineer's Office has requested that the resolution contains wording that the Township will pay for the materials used in the culvert replacement. On the speed reduction on Shadowy Hills Drive at Mr. Salmon's request he checked with the Engineer's Office Plat room to see if the area is a platted subdivision and if so the Trustees can set the speed limit without doing the traffic study. It is a platted subdivision. He has also received pricing from L.E. Scofield Window and Door on replacing the door between the meeting room and shop area and replacing the rear windows in the shop area with smaller windows including the block work to enclose the area where the larger windows are. The new door would be \$685.00 and the window work would be \$4800.00. On Coulter Lane the Abell property at 5349 has honeysuckle in the road right-a-way and when he went out there in September to mow it back the daughter of the resident came out and stated that they had some coming that weekend to trim the honeysuckle. It still has not been done and he would like the Trustees to send a letter to the resident to see if they are going to do the trimming in the near future, if not he will go back out a trim it back. Mr. Salmon said he will send the letter.

Police Report

Police Chief Michael Goins reviewed the police report he had given the Trustees at the beginning of the meeting.
